Wrap Up

1. Integration of NRDS in overarching frameworks

- The presented case studies provide the CARD countries with lessons for NRDS integration, such as common approaches, success factors and critical conditions.
- Other CARD member countries must benefit from learning these lessons especially for mainstreaming, thus NRDS implementation

2. Interventions in rice value chain

- Success Cases presented are not exhaustive (we still have drafts for another 3-4 cases)
- Intervention areas vary at each case, and difficult to summarize them.
- However, the best practices and analysis on their scalability provide a number of clues/ implications to other countries (e.g. Utilization of market/ business force for effective PPP, Roles of public sector)
- Analysis of all cases will be compiled and synthesized, taking the comments and feed back from this workshop
- Analysis will be disseminated through publication



Wrap Up

2. Interventions in rice value chain

Through working on the best practice analysis, we found the Scalability Assessment Framework developed by IFAD is quite useful tool to see the adoptability/ scalability of one practice to other contexts

However.....,

- Presented Analysis are generic

Therefore, for adoption of best practice, the respective country should conduct detailed Scalability Assessment in their specific contexts

Feb – Mar 2014	The draft of those cases will be compiled together with analysis and synthesis for documentation (Draft document is already available for 5 cases in value chain intervention).
Mar 2014	Circulation of drafts for comments/ feedback (SC members)
Apr – May 2014	Revision and Finalization of Draft
May – June 2014	Publication
June 2014 -	Dissemination to African Countries & Development Partners
