





What is CARD?

- is a consultative group of bilateral and multilateral donors and African and international institutions
- aims at <u>doubling the rice production</u> in Sub-Sahara Africa by 2018
- fully respects <u>African ownership and</u>
 <u>leadership</u> (CAADP, AfricaRice, FARA etc)



Objectives

- Increase investment for rice-related development mainly through <u>existing funding framework</u>
 - Develop <u>capacity of SSA Governments</u> to effectively manage rice sector development as well as to secure government funding / donor investment
 - Provide <u>enabling environment</u> for rice-related investment both for development agencies and SSA Governments



Objectives

- Better coordinate interventions based on the shared view on rice development (NRDS)
 - NRDS: in line with overarching development framework (PRSP, CAADP)





Guinea, Sierra Leone

- Updating and needs-resources gap
- Priority intervention topics (outputs) for the immediate round of funding (Gov't, DP, CAADP)
- Detailed actions identified to involve key institutions and players
- In-country dialogue between NRDS Task Force and CAADP Country Team arranged
- Year 2011: Operationalisation of priority interventions



Côte d'Ivoire, Liberia

- Officially approved as the CARD Second Group countries at the GM3 (May 2010)
- Expert consultation and peer review of NRDS zero draft at the regional workshop at Africa Rice Centre, Benin (July 2010)
- Post-workshop procedures



Alignment with CAADP (CSP)

- To expand the possibility of funding to rice sector development.
- Dialogue started between CARD Secretariat and NPCA (NEPAD)
- In-country exchange between the NRDS Task Force and CAADP country team started / is to start in the First Group countries
- Year 2011: more systematic exchange of NRDS and CAADP processes for enhanced integration of NRDS into CAADP in-country process
