2. Current Situation concerning CARD (Coalition for African Rice Development) and NRDS (National Rice Development Strategy) in country

(1) Achievements, on-going activities, and way forward

Major Point of NRDS:

- Irrigation and Water Management Promotion and Soil according to the Agro ecological Zones
- Development and Improving Market Access Capacities
- Support to Best Access to Agriculture Facilities
- Improvement of Rice value chain by Research and Agriculture Council

After launching NRDS-Guinea process from 17 – 18 February 2009, it was adopted by government in May 2009. The focal point and the task force with the technical and financial support of CARD have already organized:

-First working week (WW1) from December 20 to December 24, 2010, for which the principal outputs were: (i)Elaboration of SIEM – Resources,(ii) Elaboration of SIEM – Needs, (iii) Identification of priority interventions and (iv)Definition of Gaps.

-Second working week (WW2) from May 23 to May 27, 2011, for which the principal outputs were: (i) Updating the Gaps, (ii) Elaboration of 6 concept Notes and (iii) Elaboration of rough ideas of the promotion materials and the brochure.

-Third working week (WW3)from May 21 to May 25, 2012 : The expected outputs were: (i) Reduction of the number of Concept Notes from 6 to 4 in view of having a coherence with the 4 sub-programs of Sustainable Rice Development which is the first component of the CAADP national plan called “ Plan National d’Investissement Agricole et de Sécurité Alimentaire” (PNIASA), (ii) Inclusion of the zoning approach into the Concept Notes and (iii) Updating and finalization both of promotion materials and the brochure.

The achievements of the WW3 are:

(i)The concept notes are now 4 instead of 6, (ii) the zoning approach was partially applied because of lack of data.

The way forward: (i) To collect all data related to the zoning approach, (ii) To strengthen the Concept Notes by applying the zoning approach from the collected available data and (iii) To update and finalize both the promotion materials and the brochure.

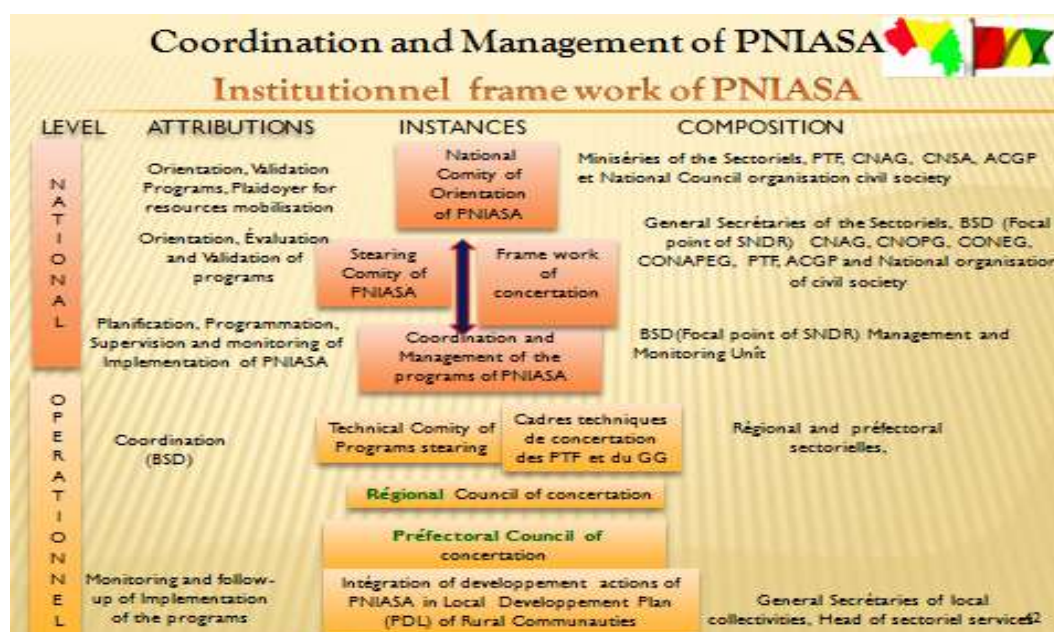
