### **CARD Action 2012 – Mechanization Support Plan**

#### Goal

- To promote rice mechanization in selected countries through:
  - o adoption of appropriate technology options;
  - implementation of appropriate policy / institutional arrangements
     to optimize the performance of the private sector, and;
  - o implementation of interventions to materialize the above two.

## **Objectives**

- To identify appropriate technology options (types and specification of machineries) for rice production in each of participating countries
- To identify policy / institutional bottlenecks for the provision of enabling environment for the private sector and advocate relevant ministries for favorable changes
- To formulate the plan of interventions for consideration by the development partners
