III. GOVERNMENT 'S ACHIEVEMENTS

- Establishment of a tractor service workshop at Kabuye (Kigali)
- Establishment of a tractor selling service to farmers and other private operators
- Establishing an organized hiring system of farm machinery to farmers
- •Training on operation and maintenance of tractors and power tillers
- Marketing through various communications channels
- •Roll out the program through setting-up of VMSCs
 - So far 9 village mechanization service centers are established (Bugesera, Kirehe, Ngoma, Nyagatare, Gatsibo, Nyanza, Gicumbi & Kabuye)

To ensure access to farm Machinerys purchasing & selling machines



- Total purchased power tillers: 250
- PT sold to farmers: 58
- PT located in VMSCs: 48
- Total power PT remaining for sell: 144



- Total tractors imported so far: 50
- Tractors sold to farmers: 14
- Tractors in hiring & selling systems: 36

Key implementation challenges

- Low rate of buying machines by individual farmers or farmer's organizations
- Land conditions: most of people hiring machines have virgin and very hard lands
- Very high demand of tractor hire in short period (most of farmers want to hire machines at the same time-pick of season)
- Logistics issues due to small landholding:
 - High operation costs due to frequent movement of machines
 - Close follow-up of operators across the country is very demanding

V. PRIVATE SECTOR

Private Enterprises contribute to the government mechanization efforts by rendering hire services of machineries, sales and services of machines.

Financial units (BRD, BPR, VFC,....) – render access to financial services for purchasing machineries through various financial products.



VI. CONCLUSION

Through mechanization continuous efforts, the (NRDS) National Rice Development Strategies will lead:

- To achieve self sufficiency in rice production by 2018,
- To substantially raise competitiveness of Rwanda rice in local and regional markets.
- To raise the productivity level from 5.8t/Ha to 7.0t/Ha,
- To expand the area under cultivation from 6,838 Ha to 26 000 Ha by 2018.
