

Constraints for Implementation of NRDS

- Research : Collection and preservation of genetic material and the import and selection of genetic material from abroad
- Seed Production: Comprises the genetic purification and increase in production of seed of improved varieties
- Infrastructure: Irrigation schemes (less than 3% of total rice cultivated area that is irrigated
- Technology Transfer: technology packages adapted for each Cluster and production system
- Agro-Processing: Rehabilitation of existing milling factories and

Acquisition of new milling machinery


