Main Training Aspects (1/2):
Plot level rice cultivation practices

Good variety, pure seeds, well banded and levelled plots, young seedlings transplanted in straight rows, azolla utilisation, early weeding, water management, etc.
Let rice seedlings in a plot grow, develop and mature uniformly.

Logical and practical for farmers

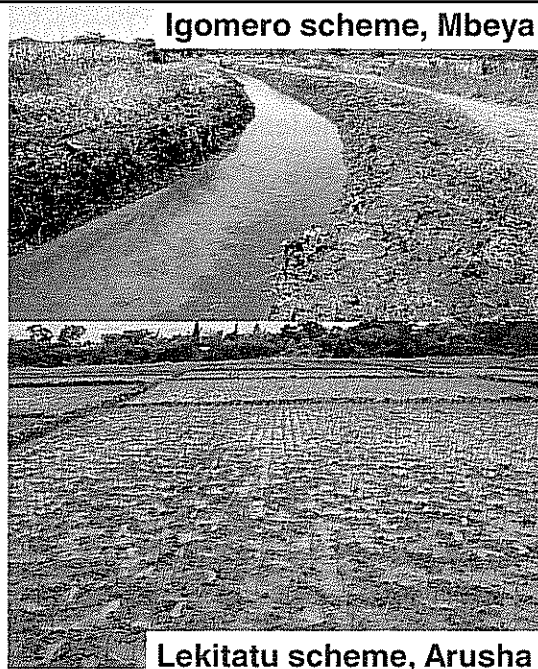

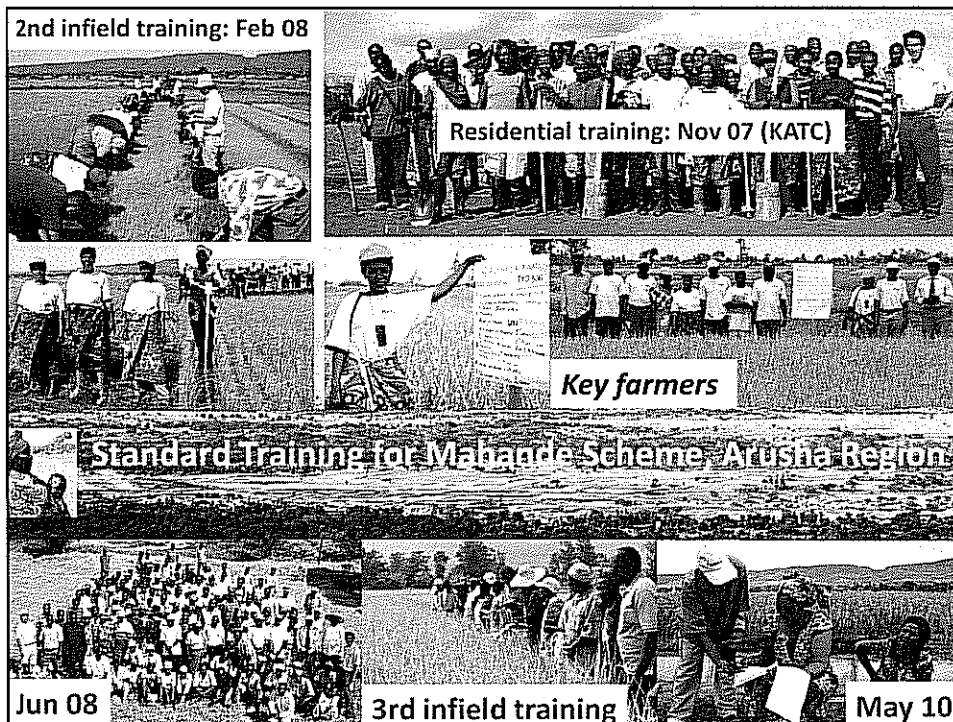
Main Training Aspects (2/2): Scheme level management

Mind set of beneficiaries

Uniform growth and maturity of rice plants in every plot and each irrigation block through organised efforts of stakeholders sticking to the irrigation plan, rice cropping calendar and irrigation scheme management

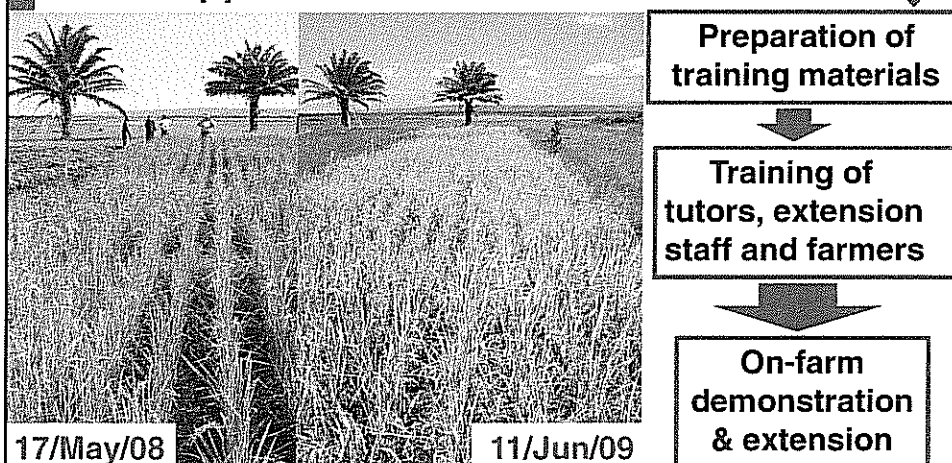


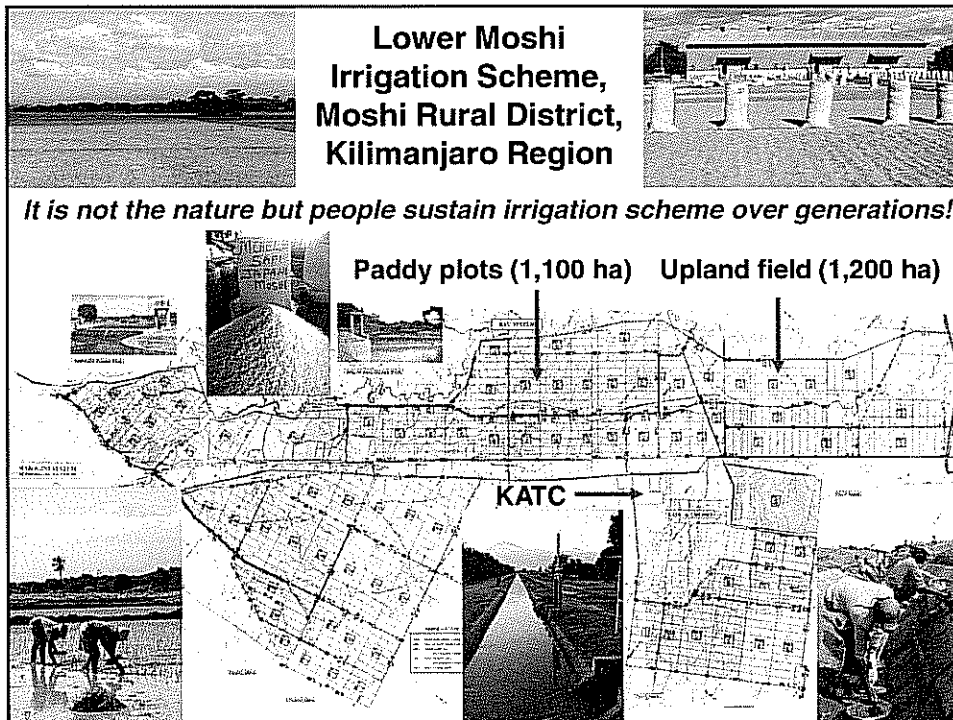




Impact of Linkage: Lekitatu, Arusha Region
