
### CARD (Coalition for African Rice Development);

- aims at <u>doubling rice production</u> in Sub-Sahara Africa by 2018
   Overall Goal
- is <u>a consultative group</u> of bilateral and multilateral donors and African and international organizations/institutions
  - Steering Committee members; AfDB, Africa Rice Center, AGRA, FAO, FARA, IFAD, IRRI, JICA, JIRCAS, NEPAD, WB
- works in 23 CARD member countries
- provides various kinds of support, but not financial one



Rice Production in Sub-Saharan Africa (1000MT)




