### CARD(Coalition for African Rice Development);

- was established in 2008 at TICAD IV by AGRA, NEPAD, and JICA
- aims at doubling rice production in Sub-Sahara Africa by 2018
   Overall Goal
- is a consultative group of bilateral and multilateral donors and African and international organizations/institutions
  - Steering Committee members; AfDB, Africa Rice Center, AGRA, FAO, FARA, IFAD, IRRI, JICA, JIRCAS, NEPAD, WB
- fully respects <u>African ownership and leadership</u>
  - Participation of African Institutions, AfricaRice, AfDB, FARA, NEPAD
  - Alignment to CAADP
- provides various types of support, but not financial one
- works in 23 CARD member countries







### **Policy/Capacity Track**

Identify key policy tools/institutional capacities in facilitating mechanization value chain (particularly in enabling environment for the private sector)

#### **Technical Track**

Identify specifications of required machineries for different *ecosystems* of rice production

Formulate intervention plans to build on the outputs from the identification work on Technical and Policy/Capacity tracks



Rice Production in Sub-Saharan Africa (1000MT)







## 5. Where CARD goes? – Way Forward Extra information

#### <Toward the end of 2018>

- Accelerating the implementation of NRDS and thematic strategies such as Seeds and mechanization: that will lead to increasing the Number of "CARD-Labeled Projects"
- Continue other support activities such as capacity development, promotion of PPP, strengthening partnerships among rice stakeholders, and Knowledge and Information sharing

### **<Beyond 2018>**

- CARD will continue from 2019 on as a 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase. (2019-2030)
- Goal "To further double rice production in Sub-Sahara Africa"
- Expanded membership (+10 new CARD countries)
- Possible expansion of partners (in its Steering Committee)
- More emphasis on policy advocacy (through NEPAD and others)
