CARD(Coalition for African Rice Development);

- was established in 2008 at TICAD IV by AGRA, NEPAD, and JICA
- aims at <u>doubling rice production</u> in Sub-Sahara Africa by 2018
 Overall Goal
- is a consultative group of bilateral and multilateral donors and African and international organizations/institutions
 - Steering Committee members; AfDB, Africa Rice Center, AGRA, FAO, FARA, IFAD, IRRI, JICA, JIRCAS, NEPAD, WB
- fully respects <u>African ownership</u> and <u>leadership</u>
 - Participation of African Institutions, AfricaRice, AfDB, FARA, NEPAD
 - Alignment to CAADP
- provides supports, but not financial one
- works in 23 CARD member countries

< Values of NRDS development and Implementation>

- All these process is carried out by the government of CARD member states. CARD provides only facilitation. (Strengthened Capacity in planning and implementation, country-owned Strategy make application possible)
- Tailor-made strategy specific to the respective country (Optimal, needs-based)
- Commodity-based focus (enable comprehensive interventions across the whole value chain)
- Commonly-shared strategy for rice sector development (better coordination of stakeholders)

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




