


Import-reliance affect Food System and Trade Balance






Milled rice (5-year average, 2016-2020); FAOSTAT_07/2022

EAC Regional Rice Platform (ERP)

- Launched in Nairobi under GIZ/ AGRA/ CARI-EA program
- Involving basically 2 representatives from partner states (one from public, another from private sector)
- to meet twice a year to discuss the development of the rice sector in the region
- ERP working to formulate the EAC Rice Development Strategy (ERDS) with support from EAC/ Kilimo Trust/ CARD.
- NRDS FPs in each member state are invited for providing necessary information about NRDS with the regional perspective.



EAC Rice Platform Launching January 2020 (at Nairobi)

East Africa Rice Conference organized by IRRI, JICA, APRA, AfricaRice, Kubota, CARD

19-20 May 2021

- EARC served as a platform for accomplishing the ambitious plan of strengthening domestic rice production by bringing together key players in the sector and initiating substantive discussions on the opportunities and challenges that it faces.
- As rice becomes a strategic commodity in Africa, many countries have embarked on various programs that, along with continental initiatives, aspire to chart a course of action for moving the regional rice sector forward.

Independent Dialogue to UNFSS (towards sustainable Rice based food systems in Africa)

29 July 2021

- This Dialogue aims to bring together a range of stakeholders across the food system to respond to the challenge of building sustainable value chains for the African rice sector Specifically, the dialogue aims to address these three questions:
 - 1) How has the African rice sector responded to multiple regional and global crises
 - 2) What do policymakers do in response to these crises and to the surging increase in imports?
 - 3) How can we shift stakeholder perspectives towards integrating nutrition and health in agricultural activities and research





Now we are waiting for the decision of the ERO board on whether they accommodate the CARD indicators as part of their indicators.





- Which region do we support next as CARD?




ERDS Implementation Structure
