## 1. The 8th Tokyo International Conference for African Development (TICAD8) and CARD Side Event

- ➤ TICAD8 was held in Tunisia on 27 and 28 August, 2022 and the result was compiled as the Tunis Declaration. 100386626.pdf (mofa.go.jp)
- ➤ JICA organized a CARD side event online on August 22, with speakers including the President of Madagascar, President of AfDB, President of AGRA, and President of JICA.
- Confirmed that CARD is becoming increasingly important in the midst of the food crisis triggered by the invasion of Ukraine.

## 2. JICA's On-going Projects under CARD

- > Developing "JICA's Strategy on Rice Development in Africa" (to be completed by February next year)
- Conduct <u>Technical Cooperation Projects and Yen Loan/Grant Aid Projects</u> in specific member countries in line with NRDS.
- ➤ In addition to the above, implemented/Planned HRD (Training Program).
- 2021: Remote training based in Japan and Egypt.
- 2022: Face-to-face/remote training in Japan, Thailand, Senegal, Tanzania, Uganda, Cameroon, and Egypt.

#### < Three Basic Policies of Cooperation>

#### 1. Steady increase in rice production


- Improvement in productivity
- Expansion of production areas

#### 2. Robust Value Chain building

- Reduction of rice production costs
- Quality improvement and stable supply

#### 3. Work with governments and development partners

- Expanding the market for locally produced rice
- Continuous and further expansion of rice cultivation by farmers





## 3. Strategic Implementation of Grant Aid for CARD Promotion

- Introducing as a part of NRDS implementation, building on the outcomes of JICA's technical assistance
- Target Countries: On-going (Nigeria, Zambia, and Madagascar), Preparing (Ghana, Cote d'Ivoire, Kenya, and other countries.)
- ✓ <u>Nigeria, Zambia, and Madagascar</u>: Strengthen seed production capacity through the establishment of agricultural research institutes.
- ✓ Ghana: Strengthen seed production capacity for irrigation schemes.
- ✓ <u>Cote d'Ivoire</u>: Improve agricultural machinery for cultivation, harvesting and post-harvest handling
- ✓ Kenya : Improve irrigation facilities


## 4. Hubs for Agricultural Mechanization

(Africa Field Innovation Center for Agricultural Technology (AFICAT))

- Implementing through public-private partnership
- Promotion of advanced technologies including agricultural machinery by <u>Japanese private companies</u>, in Kenya, Tanzania, Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana and Nigeria
- African private companies will be also involved.



5. Developed 'JICA Technical Manual for Rice Cultivation in Africa – CARD Implementation Review 2008-2018 –'



- Summarized the technical assets accumulated during the CARD1 period
- Useful to formulate and implement rice related projects in SSA
- In four languages (EN, FR, PT, JP)
