TABLE 1: PRODUCTION (1000 T) AND AREA HARVESTED (HA)

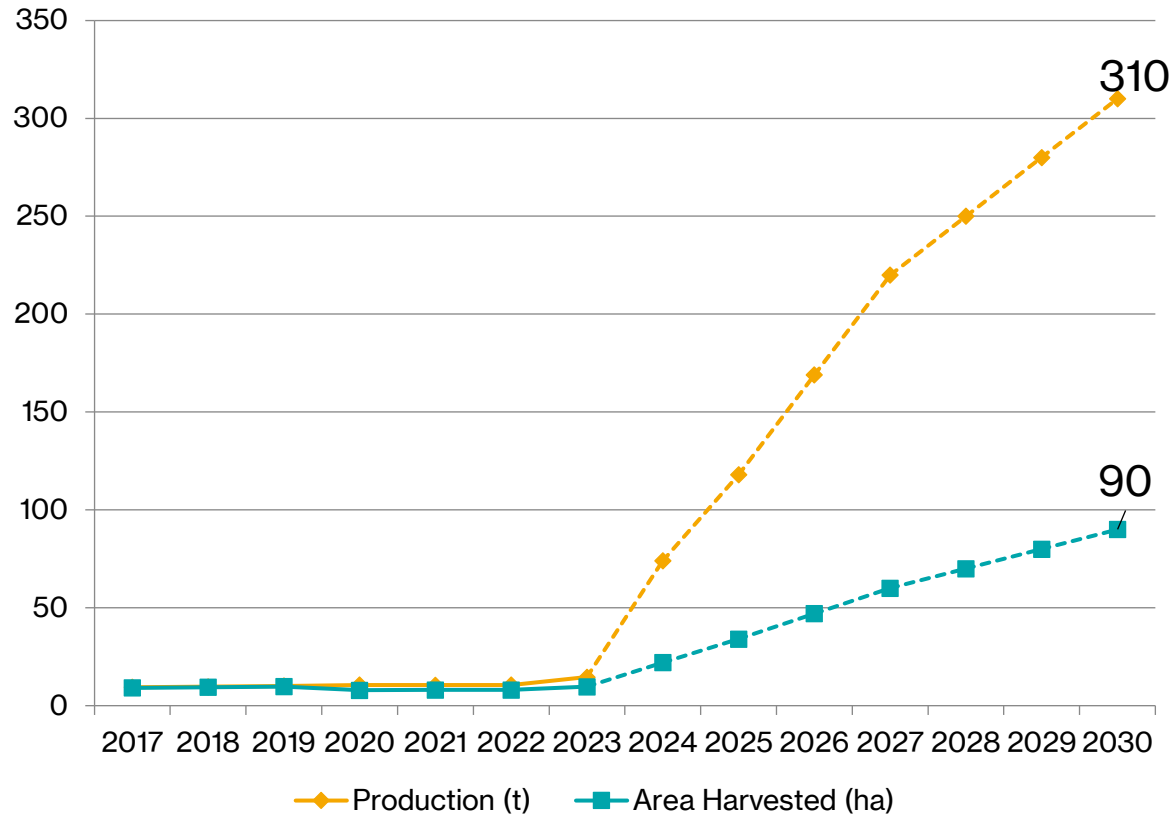


TABLE 2: YIELD (T/HA)

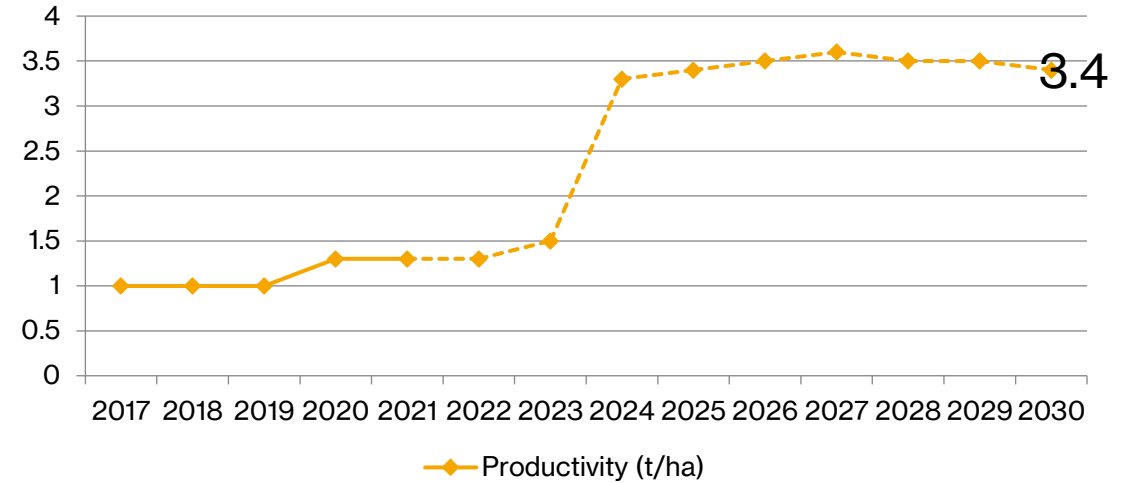
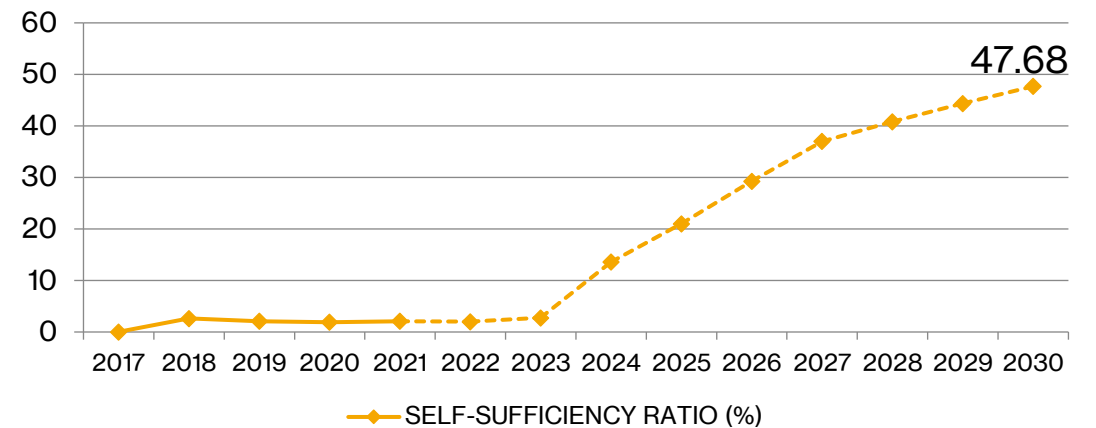


TABLE 3: SELF SUFFICIENCY RATIO (%)



Identified priority areas and Concept Notes

Priority areas

- 1) Production of certified seed and quality declared seed;
- 2) Conducting adaptability tests for selection of rice varieties by ecosystem;
- 3) Mobilization of financial resources by the Government for mechanized land preparation;
- 4) Construction and/or rehabilitation of irrigation systems;
- 5) Deployment of rice husking machines;
- 6) Revitalisation of the rice value chain;
- 7) Fertilizer mobilization.

1. Concept Notes

- 1) As of January 2024, the Rice Development Project will be implemented with support from JICA in the provinces of Moxico and Lunda Sul, with the components of seed multiplication and promotion of rice production.

New Projects after Phase 2 started

After the start of Phase 2 in 2019, no project has yet been implemented in Angola. However, it should be noted that from 2013 to 2018, the Rice Crop Development Project in Angola was implemented with the support of JICA, in the provinces of Huambo and Bié.

This Project selected rice varieties, trained producers, trained technicians, prepared the technological package of rice culture and recommended adaptability tests in other regions of the country. Under this project, the NRDS 1 was prepared in 2018, with the goal of CARD membership.

VC development through private sector involvement

MARCIRIS, LTD.

Who they are

- 1) Company specialised in the production, husking and marketing of rice.
- 2) It has been operating in Luquembo municipality, in Malanje province since 2022.

What they are doing

- 1) It produces rice and dehusks it on its own premises (1 dehusker, 5 t/hour); In the 2022-2023 agricultural campaign, it harvested 4,000 tons of rice on 600 ha of land.
- 2) It sells branded paddy rice “luquembo rice” in 25-kg bags in supermarkets in Luanda and Malanje.

Impacts

- 1) Rice production in the area increased from 344 t to 4,500 t, with an improvement in yield from 0.8 t/ha to 3.7 t/ha.
- 2) Creation of 200 jobs.

Support from the Public sector

Loan application for the purchase of tractors, agricultural equipment, rice husking machine and infrastructure construction.



VC development through private sector involvement

1. BONSAE, LTD.

Who they are

- 1) Company specialised in rice production, husking, marketing and research.
- 2) Established in 2016 in Luanda, but with operations in Malanje province.

What they are doing

- 1) Contract with 700 farmers, providing high quality seeds and other inputs (total 350 ha under contract);
- 2) It produces and buys rice from contracted farmers at a predetermined price and dehusks it on its own premises (1 dehusker, 1 t/hour);
- 3) It sells whitened rice under the jumbo brand in 25 kg bags in supermarkets in Luanda and Malanje.

Impacts

- 1) Rice production in the area increased from 344 t to 4,500 t, with an improvement in yield from 0.8 t/ha to 3.7 t/ha.
