1. JICA's New Initiative for Africa Food Security based on the TICAD8 Tunis Declaration of August 2022

- Launched 'JICA Africa Food Security Initiative Achieving Human Security through Food and Agricultural Development with Partners-" based on the TICAD8 Tunis Declaration which confirms support for improving food security and nutrition, sustainable agriculture, and food systems in Africa.
- Support for CARD is positioned as most important activity to the implementation of the above initiative.
- Details will be described in the next slide.

2. JICA's On-going Projects under CARD

- ➤ JICA's strategy for supporting CARD will be explained at the board meeting. JICA will continue to provide strong support for CARD with three pillars, as described in the next following slide.
- Conduct <u>Technical Cooperation Projects and Yen Loan/Grant Aid Projects</u> in specific member countries in line with NRDS. See Another slide (On-gong project map)
- In addition to the above, implemented/Planned HRD (Training Program) through face-to-face/remote training in Japan, Thailand, Senegal, Tanzania, Uganda, Cameroon, and Egypt.



JICA Africa Food Security Initiative

-Achieving Human Security through Food and Agricultural Development with Partners-

The TICAD 8 Tunis Declaration of August 2022 confirms support for improving food security and nutrition, sustainable agriculture, and food systems in Africa. ⇒JICA sets goals of: (1)Food Production equivalent to the energy (food) requirement of 250 mil people and contribute to improve nutrition for 270,000 people by 2030; and (2) Training of 200,000 agricultural human resources in next 3 years: to realize food security (Availability, Access, Utilization, Stability) through ca. 190 bil. yen (US\$ 1.4 bil.) assistance (*)

1.Food Production (Availability): ca.160 bil. yen (US\$ 1.2bil.)

* Total of projects in progress and planned. The total does not equal the figures in the chart below due to overraps of projects among the four pillars.

- (1) Emergency: 40 bil. ODA Loan (US\$ 300 mil.) with AfDB
- 46 mil people energy (food) requirement (1,045 mil tons over the next two years)


(2)Mid-Long Term (Promotion of <u>CARD2</u>) :ca. 120 bil. yen (US\$ 900 mil.)

- Contribute to doubling rice production (56 mil. t) by 2030 =200 mil. people energy (food) requirement
- Training <u>150,000 human resources on rice farming</u> during TICAD8



Stable increase of rice production


- ➤ Increase in yield

- ➤ Increase in production area


Quality and stable supply throughout Value Chain (VC) actors

- Higher competitiveness of domestic rice in the market
- Strengthen Network among VC actors: Miller, Finance, Agr. Machinery, Post-Harvest, Quality Seed Production, Marketing

Capacity building of governments and Partnership

- > Rice Development Strategy (NRDS/ERDS) and Concept Note
- > Information Sharing, M&E Baseline Survey & Monitoring
- > Technical Advices for ECOWAS Rice Observatory
- Training in Japan and others (Senegal, Cameroon, Egypt, Thailand)





3. Strategic Implementation of Grant Aid for CARD Promotion

- ➤ To be introduced as a part of NRDS implementation, building on the outcomes of JICA's technical assistance
- Target Countries: On-going (Madagascar, Zambia, Nigeria, Ghana and Cote d'Ivoire), Preparing (Kenya, and other countries)
- ✓ <u>Nigeria, Zambia, and Madagascar</u>: Strengthen seed production capacity through the establishment of agricultural research institutes.
- ✓ Ghana: Strengthen seed production capacity for irrigation schemes.
- ✓ <u>Cote d'Ivoire</u>: Improve agricultural machinery for cultivation, harvesting and post-harvest handling
- ✓ Kenya : Improve irrigation facilities

4. Promote Agricultural Mechanization with Private sector participation

(Africa Field Innovation Center for Agricultural Technology (AFICAT))

- ➤ To be implemented through public-private partnership
- For promotion of advanced technologies including agricultural machinery by <u>Japanese private</u> companies, in Kenya, Tanzania, Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana and Nigeria
- African private companies will be also involved.
- > Public and private sector representatives from 5 countries were invited to Japan.



5. Developed 'NERICA Potential Map for 32 CARD Member Countries'


- Created NERICA cultivation potential maps for 32 target countries using satellite data, rainfall data, etc.
- It will be available on the CARD Secretariat website, and we hope it will be used for upland rice promotion in the future.

6. Created Video Material for Seed Multiplication

- Created as a teaching material for training in Japan
