




Overall indicators

Paddy rice production and harvested area





Progress of CARD activities since AG9

Progress on NRDS development processes

❖ Development phase:

- Revision of the NRDS from 20 September 2023 to March 2024;
- Validation workshop held on 24 May 2024 with the support of the IDB and JICA, chaired by the Minister of Agriculture.

❖ Development of Concept Notes (CN):

- Development workshop held in February 2025.

Progress on the M&E phase of the NRDS

❖ Monitoring phase

- February 2025 discussion on the choice of indicators for monitoring the NRDS using the RICE approach.
- From March 2025 to present, data collection on the Biennial Review and the development of the national input and seed strategy
- Data collection for monitoring the dynamics of the NRDS indicators is ongoing
- National Agriculture and Livestock Census (RNAE) in progress (supported by FAO)

Good example and challenge in implementing the NRDS

<Challenge>

- Mobilisation of financial resources (insufficient public investment, lack of private investment and heavy dependence on external aid);
- Low involvement or motivation of the private sector;
- Inadequate storage infrastructure (significant post-harvest losses, difficulties in stabilising prices)

<Good Example>

- Establishment of a multi-stakeholder platform for the rice value chain by PRORIL and PDCVR;
- The definition of a clear vision and reference framework for the sector (NRDS) has facilitated the implementation of a new rice project with the IDB, "Programme to support the strengthening of women's enterprises in the rice value chain in West Africa (EWASME)", as well as with the AFD through a project currently in development (SARITEM 2)...

Action plans between now and the end of 2026

- Finalisation of the five concept notes on rice;
- Monitoring of the implementation of the roadmap of the États Généraux de l'Agriculture (EGA);
- Organisation of consultations with the private sector to improve their understanding and involvement in financing the implementation of the strategy;
- Organisation of a round table of donors for the financing of the strategy;
- Organisation of the annual review of the sector.
