




Activities and Progress

Development phase

- 1 Finalisation of the NRDS in April 2025 and validation workshop in January 2026
- 2 Development of Concept Notes (CN) currently being finalised
- 3 Endorsement by the STAF of the Ministry of Agriculture: Appointment of the Rice Task Force by Ministerial Decree; Presentation of the NRDS to the Minister; Workshop chaired by the Deputy Secretary General
4. Allocation of an office to the Chad Rice Task Force within the Ministry

Best practices and challenges in implementing the SNDR

<Challenges>

- Contacts established with the World Bank and FAO
- Ensures rice-related activities for the PRSA Chad project.
- Organise regular reports to the Ministry's Secretary General

<Best practices>

- The TFR Chad has assumed responsibility for coordinating all activities of the Ministry of Agriculture related to rice cultivation and irrigated areas
- The development of the NRDS has stimulated the implementation of a new rice project with the World Bank.

Action plans between now and the end of 2026

Action 1: Organise the Indicators Workshop, the policy validation workshop with PTFs, the mid-term review

- Organise study trips to Burkina Faso, Nigeria and China
- Finalise the Concept Notes.
- Conduct interviews with the World Bank (WB) and FAO for the financing of the validation workshop

Action 2: Raise awareness among stakeholders (PTFs, private sector) about the concept notes

- Organise missions to rice-growing sites to restructure producer organisations
- Organise visits to PTFs
- Create or establish a Chadian Rice Day to promote local rice
- Create a rice fair in Chad
- Advocate for the granting of loans to actors in the rice value chain by proposing concept notes on the activities and difficulties encountered by actors
